Some triggers indicate areas of resident strengths, and can suggest possible approaches to improve a resident's functioning or minimize decline. For example, Section GG captures the resident's goals on admission when they are in an SNF PPS stay, Section F identifies the resident's preferences for customary routine and activities, and Section Q captures information about the resident's desire to talk to someone about the possibility of leaving this facility and returning to live and receive services in the community. These and other MDS items can help focus the assessment and care plan on what is most important to the resident and areas with the greatest potential for functional improvement.</p>
